Dear Business Owner:

If you choose to stay open during lockdowns and are visited by any public health official, bylaw officer or police, the following information will assist you.

- Get their name and ID #
- Ask who their supervisor is and get the supervisor's name and ID #
- Record the event

PREPARE YOURSELF TO SAY THE FOLLOWING:

I have the right to life, liberty, and security of the person, including the right to work and provide food and shelter for my family. Your unlawful actions are in direct violation of the Canadian Constitution, the Coronation Oath, the Charter of Rights and Freedoms, the Bill of Rights, and the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. There are no provisions in any orders of any health minister, doctor, or provincial legislation, that can, nor pretend that any measures can, override Charter or other pre-Charter constitutional rights.

Even if the Federal Government had invoked the the Federal Emergencies Act, which it has not, even that Emergencies Act states:

AND WHEREAS the Governor in Council, in taking such special temporary measures, would be subject to the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms and the Canadian Bill of Rights and must have regard to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, particularly with respect to those fundamental rights that are not to be limited or abridged even in a national emergency.

I am under no moral or legal obligation to comply with any Orders to close my business. Section 52(1) of the Constitution Act, 1982, clearly states that any law that is inconsistent with the Constitution is of no force and effect. Therefore any measures taken by you to compel compliance by means of:

- Instigating confrontation
- threats to revoke my license
- harassment in an attempt to demean, humiliate, and coerce
- attempts to seize any person or property
- issuing fines

will be met with a human rights complaint and/or potential criminal charges against you.

I will hold you personally accountable and responsible for the cease and loss of my income and my ability to provide food and shelter for my family; I therefore demand you to leave my place of business and not to return.
