A few updates!

- 1) The Chair of the Board, Robert Sikora, who did not attend the last board meeting has resigned as Chair. He will continue on as Trustee but give up the role. The Trustees must elect a new Chair, but until that happens on April 14, Linda Cuff, the current Vice-Chair will assume the role of "Acting Chair."

I wouldn't encourage anyone to send a similar message, as you could find yourself facing discipline for insubordination. My position allows me a little more leeway in the area of criticizing the school board.

When you "sign" the petition with your name and PERSONAL EMAIL address, an email is sent to all of the trustees. Your home address will not appear in the message to trustees. The "reply-to" address is the email address of the person who signed the petition. Please do not use your Board email address. Once you sign the petition, a thank you email is generated and sent to your email address. The "reply-to" address for that email is office@waterloocatholicteachers.ca and is signed as coming from Waterloo Catholic Teachers.
