

## Notice of Liability:

### Freedom of Religion and Right to Assemble



#### How to Serve This Notice of Liability

- Print two copies of the Notice of Liability.
- Fill in the name of the person being served in the space provided at the top of the first page—on both copies.
- Sign your name and fill in the date in the space provided on the last page—on both copies.
- Keep one copy of the Notice for your records.
- Give the second copy to the person being served. If they choose not to accept it, then leave it on the floor at their feet.
- If you are serving the Notice in person, be sure to video record yourself serving it (or audio record if video is not possible).
- If sending by mail, you must use registered mail as that provides proof of delivery.

Keep all information (e.g. Notice of Liability copy, video, mailing proof, etc.) in a safe place for future use.

**NOTE: You do not need a lawyer to serve a Notice of Liability and you do not need consent, or the signature of the person you are serving it to.**

# Notice of Liability

### Re: Violating God's Law, the Coronation Oath, and the Constitution

Dear \_\_\_\_\_,

This is your official and personal Notice of Liability.

This Notice is to inform you that I will not be compelled to comply with any arbitrary/unlawful/unconstitutional mandates or ideologies that violate God's law, an individual's right to bodily autonomy, or citizens' rights, including parental rights.

When, as followers of Christ, we find God and our governments colliding, *"we must obey God rather than man."* (Acts 5:29)

No earthly authority has jurisdiction over the Church in terms of regulating its faith and practice, or in classifying its existence or activities as non-essential. I refuse to comply with any and all actions of the State that take coercive measures against the Church by criminalizing, inhibiting, or regulating any of the activities undertaken by the Church as acts of worship, or service to God.

Freedom of Conscience and Religion and the Right to Peaceful Assembly are protected under the Coronation Oath, the Constitution, and the Charter of Rights and Freedoms. These are fundamental, **guaranteed** rights. In addition, it is a criminal, indictable offense to obstruct, assault, threaten violence to, or arrest officiating clergy.

In 1953 Queen Elizabeth II solemnly promised and swore an oath to maintain the Laws of God and the true profession of the Gospel in the governance of the people of Canada. The Coronation Oath is a living document, and therefore any legislation in violation of biblical principles must be revoked<sup>1</sup>.

### Charter of Rights and Freedoms:

Section 2(a)

The Supreme Court of Canada has referred collectively to the Section 2 freedoms as protecting rights fundamental to Canada's liberal democratic society<sup>2</sup>.

## Criminal Code

176(1) Everyone who (a) by threats or force, unlawfully obstructs or prevents or endeavours to obstruct or prevent a clergyman or minister from celebrating divine service or performing any other function in connection with his calling, or (b) knowing that a clergyman or minister is about to perform, is on his way to perform or is returning from the performance of any of the duties or functions mentioned in paragraph (a)(i) assaults or offers any violence to him, or (ii) arrests him on a civil process, or under the pretence of executing a civil process, is guilty of an indictable offence and liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years.

There are no provisions in any orders of any health minister, doctor, or provincial legislation that can either override or pretend to override Charter or other pre-Charter constitutional rights.

According to Section 52(1) of the Constitution Act, 1982, all Laws, Statutes, Orders, By-laws, and Acts must be consistent with the Constitution ... or they are of no force or effect.

The Constitution of Canada is the supreme law of Canada, and any law that is inconsistent with the provisions of the Constitution is, to the extent of the inconsistency, of no force or effect.

Bodily autonomy: **Vaccination is voluntary in Canada**<sup>3</sup>. According to the Public Health Agency of Canada, Canadian National Report on Immunization, 1996:

“Vaccines are not mandatory in Canada; and they cannot be made mandatory because of the Canadian Constitution.”

If the Federal Government had invoked the **Federal Emergencies Act for COVID-19**, which it did not, even that Emergencies Act states:

AND WHEREAS the Governor in Council, in taking such special temporary measures, would be subject to the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms and the Canadian Bill of Rights and must have regard to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, particularly with respect to those **fundamental rights that are not to be limited or abridged even in a national emergency**.

Whilst the current government is negating the rule of law and the foundation of our democratic system in Canada by eroding rights and liberties, this will not be a defense for anyone who chooses to participate. This is an abuse of power, and a day of reckoning will come.

*You push away every thought of coming disaster, but your actions only bring the day of judgment closer. (Amos 6: 3)*

If you, acting as an individual or on behalf of any authority, obstruct or prevent clergy from celebrating divine service and/or performing any other function in connection with their calling, or prohibit Christians from assembling and worshiping the Lord, you are in violation of the Law. I therefore advise you to reconsider any involvement you may have in obstructing or violating my, or any other citizen's, guaranteed rights.

This personal Notice of Liability will be used as evidence against you, should you be found complicit in enforcing unlawful measures.
